

Wagga women attend Rabobank's agriculture forum

Agribusiness banking specialist Rabobank highlighted the invaluable role women play in their farming businesses through hosting a one-day financial empowerment workshop in Wagga Wagga last week.

"While a lot of the day was financially focussed, there was also much consideration around how financial goals fitted in with personal aspirations."

Meg Hardie from Tallimba attended the Wagga Wagga workshop and said the one-day seminar was perfectly designed for women.

"For me, it was an excellent opportunity to network with like-minded women, and there was the added bonus of obtaining financial advice," she said.

Wagga Wagga Rabobank branch manager Hamish White said the course allowed the bank to give something back to the local community, by facilitating knowledge delivery, inspiration and networking opportunities for women in agribusiness.

"The feedback from those that attended was extremely positive, with everyone saying they walked away with something, even if it was just knowing that they are on the right track," Mr White said.
